- Rose Hip Seed Oil is cold pressed from the seed pods of a plant of the Rose Family, Rosa Mosqueta which grows wild in the south of Chile.
- Suggested use as an emollient with an optimal fatty acid profile for skin. Historically this beautiful reddish orange liquid has been used for reducing acne scars, stretch marks, after-sun care, anti-aging and moisturization.
- No preservatives, additives or solvents used in the processing of this product.

Significance of linoleic acid in the skin:

This polyunsaturated fatty is “essential” to healthy hair, skin. It is essential in that the human body can not produce it, it must be acquired by the body through diet or topical application. Linoleic acid has holistic pedigree of use for rosacea, wound healing, acne, wrinkles, softness and more. There is a large body of published literature documenting and hypothesizing about the benefits of linoleic acid. For instance, it is thought to alleviate acne as individuals with acne prone skin commonly have a deficiency of linoleic acid and that treatment with it shows improvement. *Journal of American Academy of Dermatology 14:221-225, 1986).

Significance of α -Linolenic acid in the skin:

This polyunsaturated fatty acid is also an essential acid to the human body. Lack of this EFA can lead to dry itchy skin and brittle hair.

Both of these fatty acids in Rose Hip Oil are likely stabilized by the natural content of polyphenols present.
